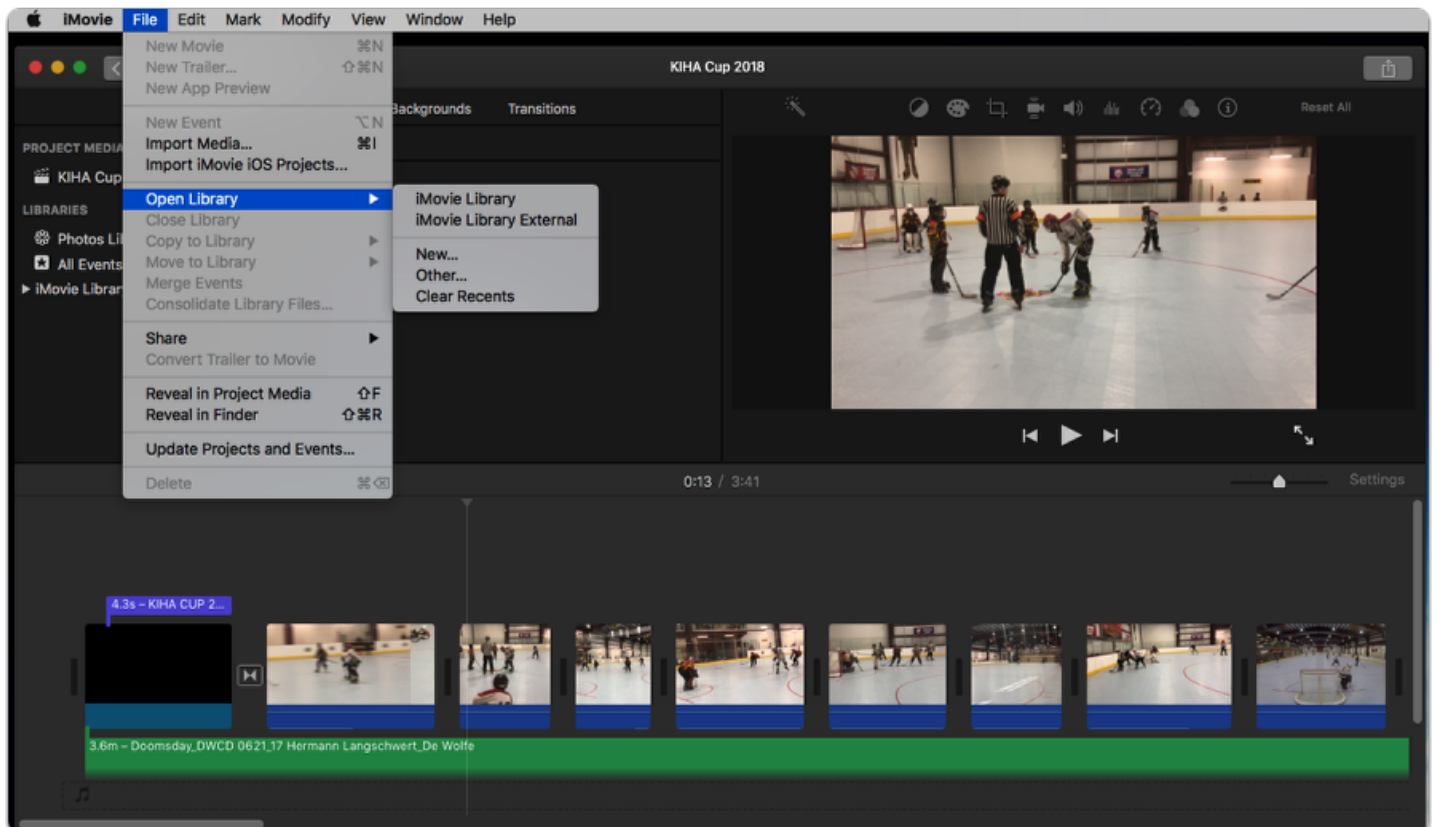


Opening and Saving iMovie Events and Projects to an External

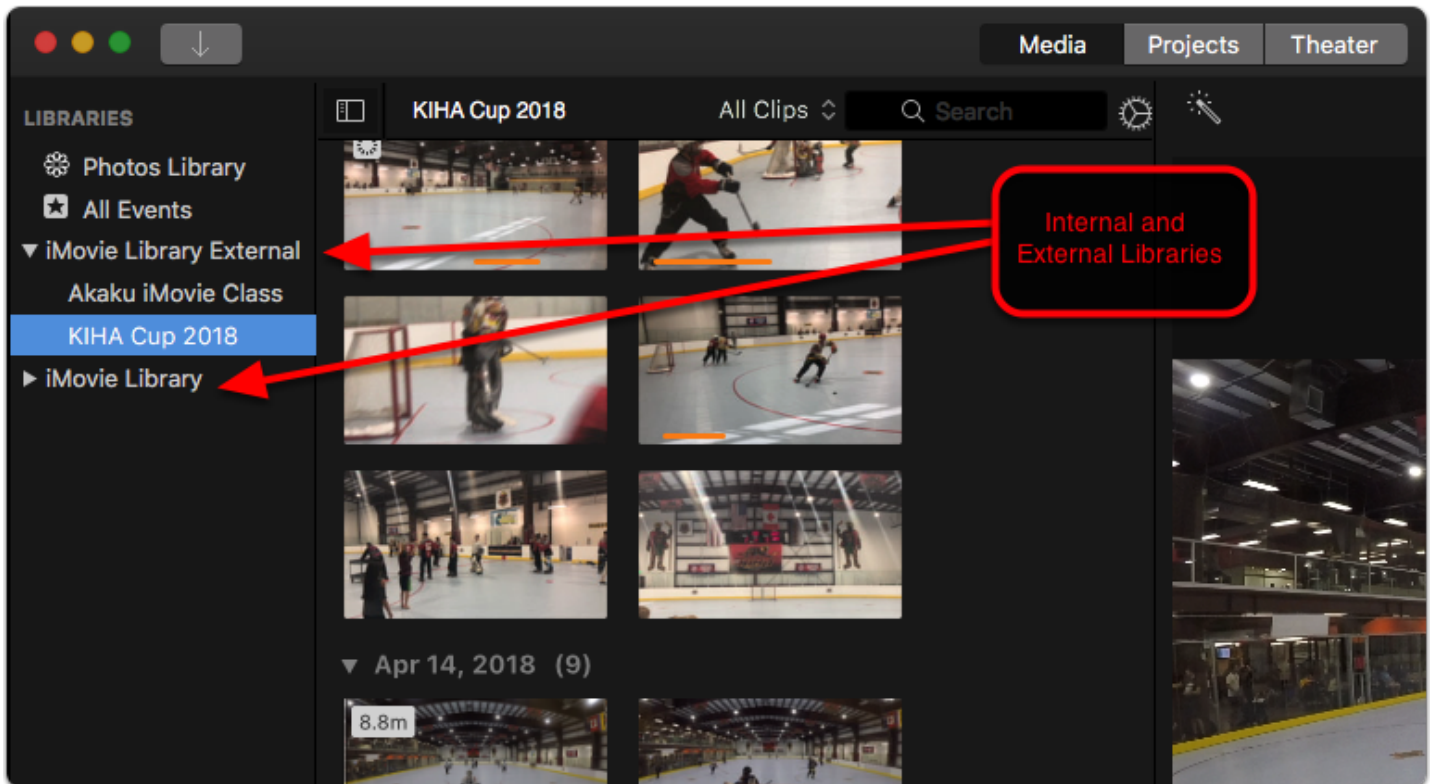
Open iMovie File from an external drive

Within iMovie go to the File Menu > Open Library. Select the name of the external drive. If it does not show in list, select Other and navigate to the external drive iMovie Library.



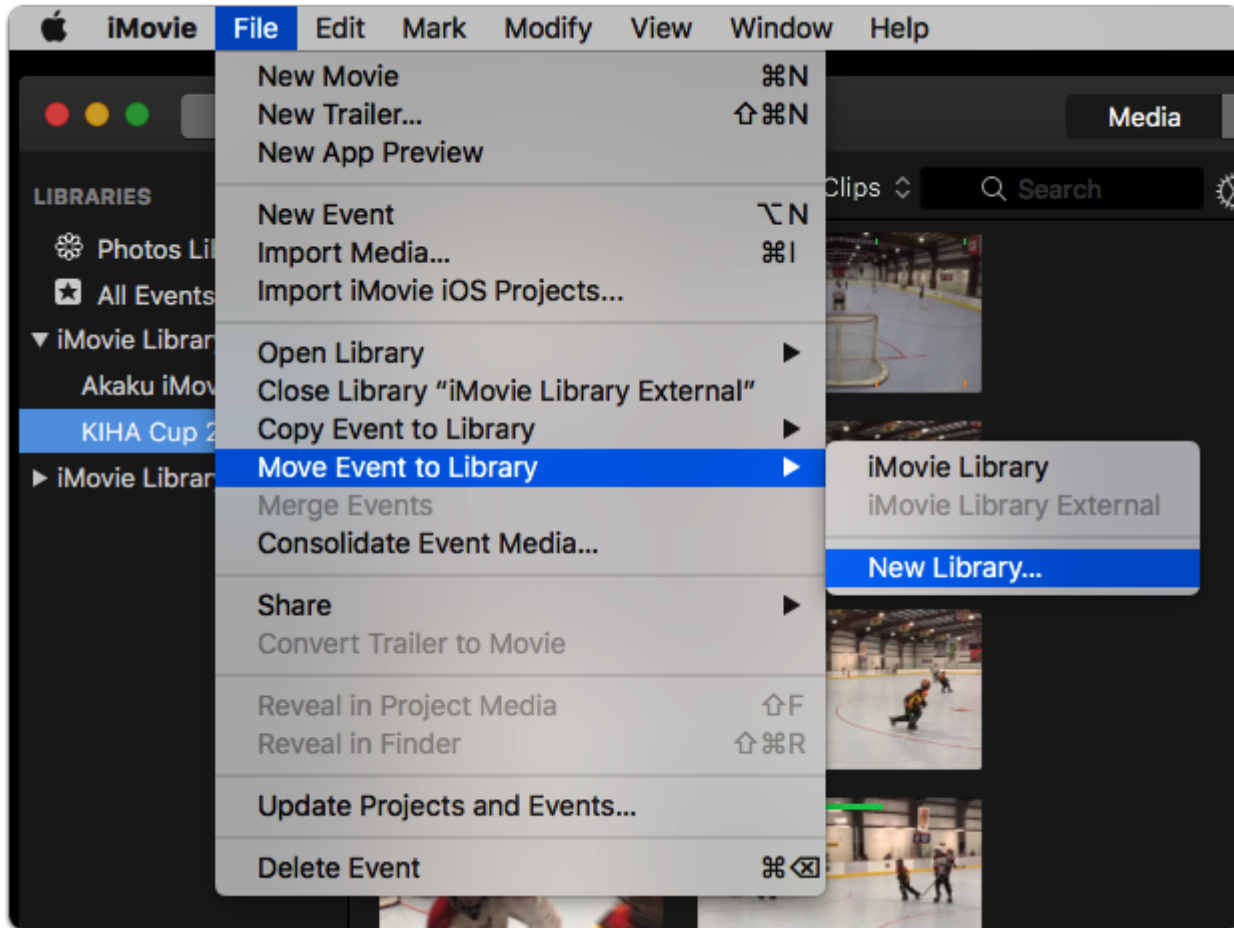
Opening and Saving iMovie Events and Projects to an External Drive

Once you open the iMovie Library from the external drive, you will now see two libraries available in the iMovie Event left sidebar.



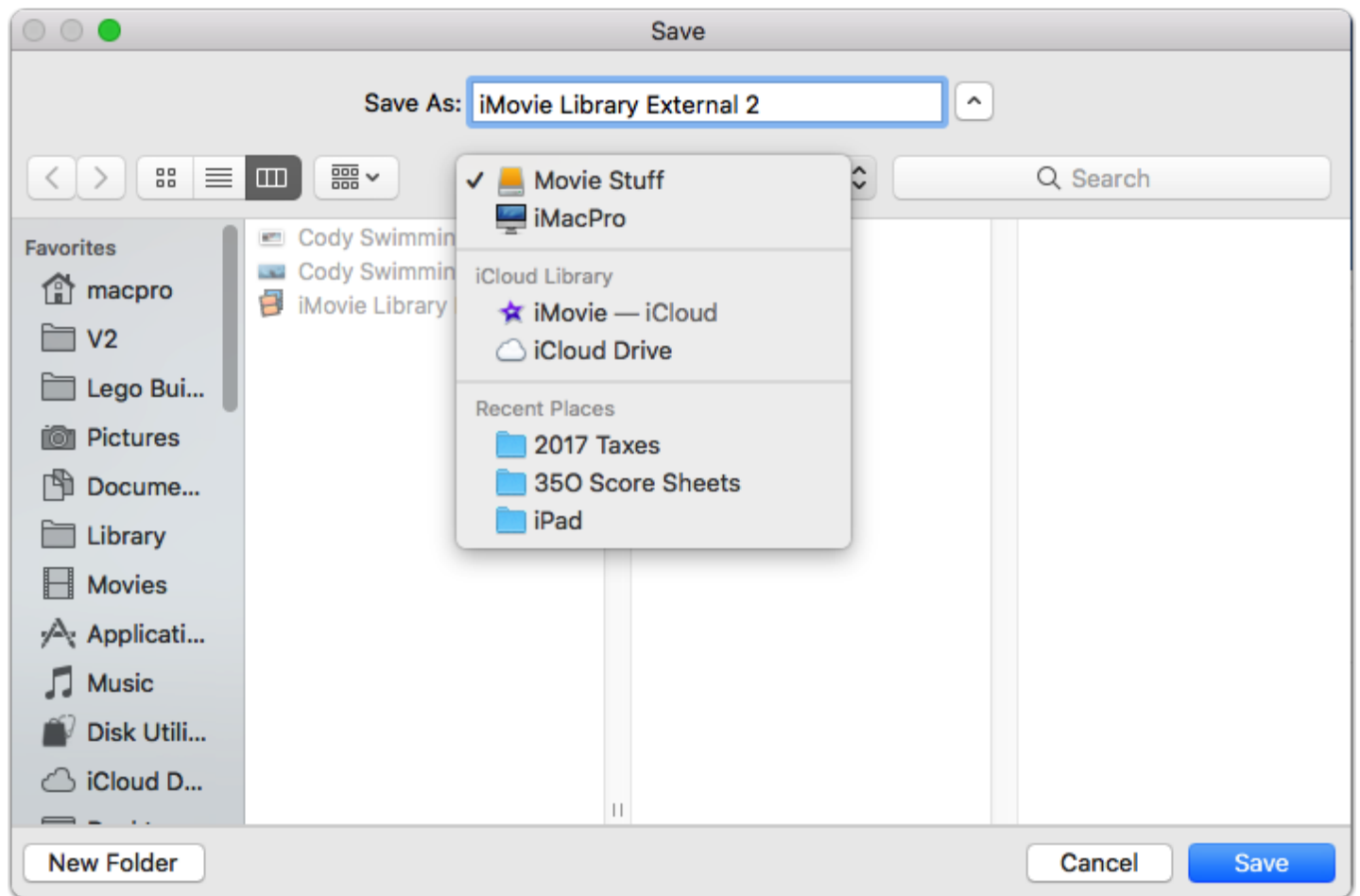
Moving Events to an External Drive

In the iMovie Event Library in the left Sidebar, select events or multiple events (hold Command Key to select more than one event). Go to the File Menu and select Move Event to Library > New Library.



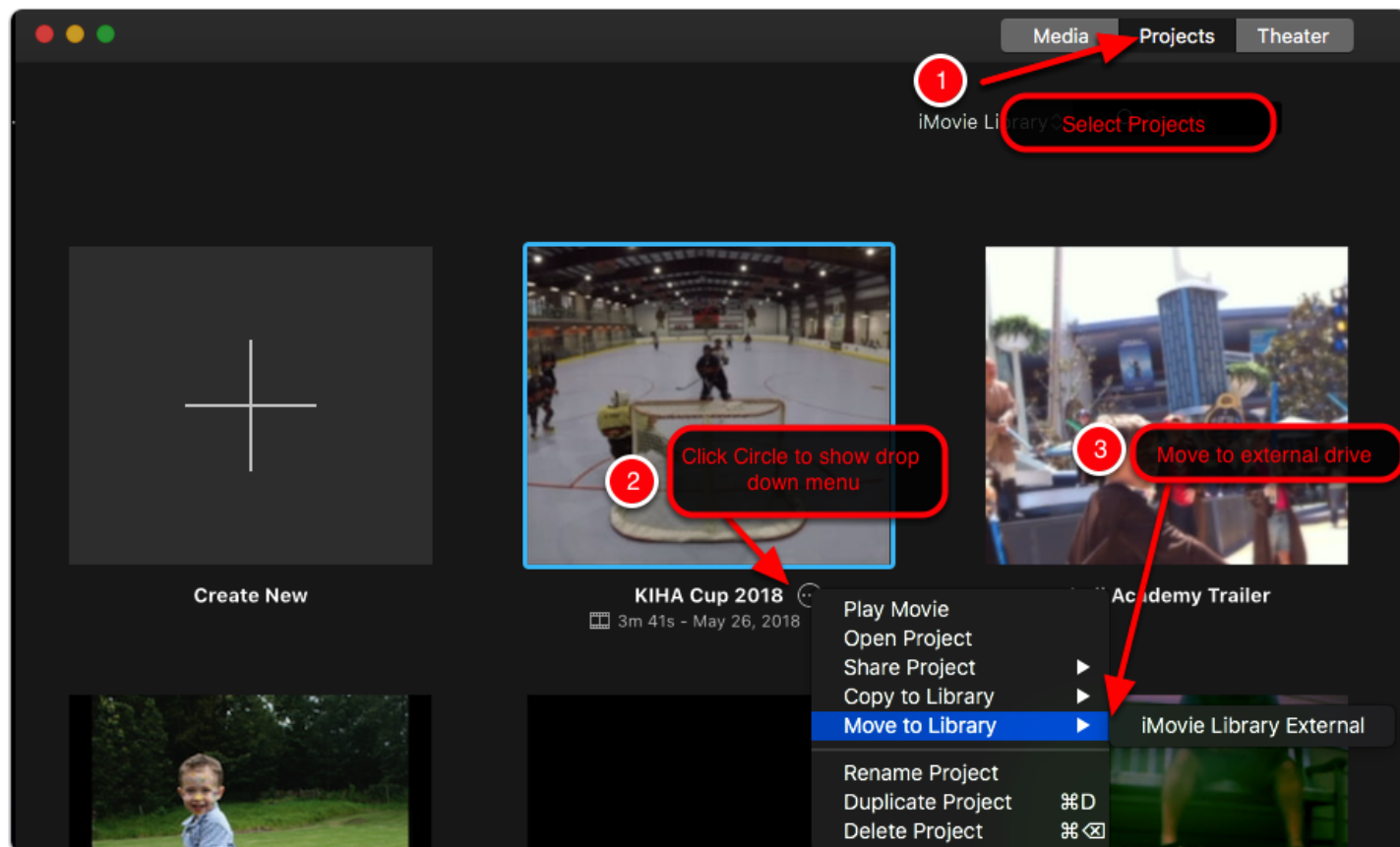
Opening and Saving iMovie Events and Projects to an External Drive

Navigate to the external drive and name your new iMovie Library. Click the Save button. Depending on how large the media files are, it may take some time to transfer to the external drive. You will see a progress indicator in the upper right window of iMovie.



Moving a Project to an external drive

To move a project, you need to make sure your external iMovie Library is opened from the previous steps. Once open, navigate to Projects, select the project and click on the drop down menu for that project. From there you can copy or move it to the external drive.



You can now plug the external drive into any other Mac and follow the steps to open your iMovie Library on that computer. You will have access to the Event Media, as well as any projects you have moved over as well.
